

ORDINANCE NO.1789

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GARDENA, CALIFORNIA, REAFFIRMING AUTHORIZATION TO COLLECT PUBLIC, EDUCATIONAL, AND GOVERNMENTAL ("PEG") FEES

WHEREAS, Section 5870 (n) of the Public Utilities Code, which as enacted as part of the Digital Infrastructure and Video Competition Act of 2006, authorized the City of Gardena to adopt an ordinance establishing a fee on state-franchised video service providers to support public, educational and governmental access channel facilities.

WHEREAS, The City adopted Ordinance No. 1704 establishing a 1% fee for the support of Public, Educational, and Governmental (PEG) access facilities and activities within the City, which is codified in Section 5.20.520 (b) of the Gardena Municipal Code.

WHEREAS, Section 5870(n) of the Public Utilities Code states that such an ordinance shall expire, and may be reauthorized, upon the expiration of a state franchise.

WHEREAS, the first state franchise to include the City, California Video Franchise Certificate Franchise No. 0020 granted to Time Warner Cable Pacific West, LLC dba Charter Communications, Inc., expired on January 1, 2018.

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GARDENA, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY ORDAIN, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The fee on state franchised video service providers to support Public, Educational, and Governmental channel facilities codified in Section 5.20.500 thru 5.20.570 of the Gardena Municipal Code, is hereby readopted and reauthorized. The fee shall remain unchanged and in full effect as to all state-franchised video service providers.

SECTION 2. Severability. If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance, or any part thereof is for any reason held to be unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion of this ordinance or any part thereof. The City Council hereby declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase be declared unconstitutional.

SECTION 3. Certification. The City Clerk shall certify the passage of this ordinance and shall cause the same to be entered in the book of original ordinances of said City; shall make a minute passage and adoption thereof in the records of the meeting at which time the same is passed and adopted; and shall, within fifteen (15) days after the passage and adoption thereof, cause the same, or a summary thereof, to be published as required by law, in a publication of general circulation.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. In accordance with Government Code Section 36937, this ordinance shall take effect immediately.
