A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GARDENA, CALIFORNIA, CALLING FOR THE HOLDING OF A GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, MARCH 5, 2024, FOR THE ELECTION OF CERTAIN OFFICERS AS REQUIRED BY THE PROVISIONS OF THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA RELATING TO GENERAL LAW CITIES

RECITALS

WHEREAS, under the provisions of the laws relating to general law cities in the State of California, a General Municipal Election shall be held on March 5, 2024, for the election of Municipal Officers; and

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GARDENA, CALIFORNIA, DOES RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. That pursuant to the requirements of the laws of the State of California relating to General Law Cities, there is called and ordered to be held in the Cityof Gardena, California, on Tuesday, March 5, 2024, a General Municipal Election for the purpose of electing a two Members of the City Council, for the full term of four years.

<u>SECTION 2</u>. That the ballots to be used at the election shall be in form and contentas required by law.

<u>SECTION 3</u>. That the City Clerk is authorized, instructed, and directed to coordinate with the County of Los Angeles Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk to procure and furnish any and all official ballots, notices, printed matter and all supplies, equipment and paraphernalia that may be necessary in order to properly and lawfully conduct the election.

<u>SECTION 4</u>. That in all particulars not recited in this resolution, the election shall be held and conducted as provided by law for holding municipal elections.

<u>SECTION 5</u>. That notice of the time and place of holding the election is given andthe City Clerk is authorized, instructed, and directed to give further or additional notice of the election, in time, form and manner as required by law.

<u>SECTION 6</u>. That the City Clerk shall certify the passage and adoption of this Resolution and enter it into the book of original Resolutions.

SECTION 7. That in the event of a tie vote (if any two or more persons receive an equal and the highest number of votes for an office) as certified by the Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk, the City Council, in accordance with Election Code § 15651(a), shall set a date and time and place and summon the candidates who have received the tie votes to appear and will determine the tie by lot.

<u>SECTION 8</u>. The City Council authorizes the City Clerk to administer said election and all reasonable and actual election expenses shall be paid by the City upon presentation of a properly submitted bill.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution; shall cause the same to be entered among the original Resolutions of said City; and shall make a minute of the passage and adoption thereof in the records of the proceedings of the City Council of said City in the minutes of the meeting at which the same is passed and adopted.
