NOTICE OF UNSCHEDULED VACANCY ON THE CITY OF GARDENA

Pursuant to Section 54974 of the California Government Code, notice is hereby given that a vacancy exists on the Gardena Senior Citizen Commission. The unexpired term ended on January 28, 2021. The successful appointee will be required to file a "Statement of Economic Interest" (Form 700) within 30 days after assuming office.

Qualifications:

- 1. Each appointee shall be a resident and a registered elector of the city for a period of one year immediately preceding appointment.
 - 2. Each appointee shall be at least fifty years of age.
- 3. Officials of the city shall not be eligible for appointment as members, except as may be provided in this chapter for ex officio members. (Ord. 1477 § 2 (part), 1994)

Meetings are held on the 4th Wednesday of each month at 12:00p.m. in the Management Information Center (MIC) of the Council Chamber at City Hall. The Committee falls within the guidelines of the Brown Act (California Government Code §54950, et seq.) and all meetings are open to the public. In addition, members are required to file Conflict of Interest Statements on an annual basis. Commissioners are paid a stipend of \$50 per meeting attended.

Applications are available at the City Clerk's Office, City Hall, 1700 West 162nd Street, Gardena CA 90247 or by calling (310) 217-9500. Please file your application no later than, **Monday, March 1, 2021**.

Appointment to the Senior Citizen Commission shall not be made by the City Council for at least ten (10) working days after posting of the notice by the City Clerk's Office.
