City Manager Medrano gave a Power Point presentation.

There was a discussion which included all Council Members and City Manager Medrano regarding the micro chip program, the impounding of animals, whether training has occurred for the employee who will be taking on this position, dead animal pick-up, and if we have to pay for dead animal disposal. Additional questions were asked: Of the \$500,000 savings, what are the start-up costs; the hours of operation; and if we can educate our residents as to what services the City will be providing vs. the County. City Manager Medrano replied that the micro chip program will be retained by the County, we will have readers eventually; we have purchased a rather cheap vehicle and will be transporting animals to the County shelters, and they will charge us for that service; some of our surrounding cities already use this program; it would be nice to eventually team up with other cities; we do pay for dead animal pick up, one of our Code Enforcement officers has shifted to this position, so we haven't had to hire anyone full time, start-up costs have been pretty minimal. Regarding the hours of operation, they will be during the day, after hour calls handled by the County. He continued, saying that the plan is to market our program, tailor our services to meet our communities needs and keep a good relationship with LA County.

- (1) MAYOR PRO TEM KASKANIAN reported that, since the last meeting, he attended the City's Flag Day Program on June 14. He also attended the Gardena Dodger Day on June 22, and said he had fun on the field. He apologized to the Police Foundation for not being able to make it to the golf tournament and congratulated them.
- (2) COUNCIL MEMBER TANAKA attended Albertson's/KABCTV Food Drive and thanked all those who participated and donated to a worthy cause. He thanked Council Member Medina for allowing him to do the invocation and benediction for the Flag Day event. He said that Gardena Day at Dodgers Stadium was a lot of fun and added that the Dodgers won. He also attended the Healthcare Partner's grand opening here in Gardena. He advised those who have not visited the brand-new facility to stop by and check out the services they offer. He thanked the Gardena Police Foundation for their fund-raising tournament, for those who participated and donated, and for the Foundation doing what they do for the City. He congratulated the Gardena Police Explorers for taking first place like they have been doing every year. He announced that he will be attending our retired Police Officer Moreno wife's funeral.

- (3) COUNCIL MEMBER HENDERSON wished his wife, Nichelle Henderson, a Happy 15<sup>th</sup> Anniversary. He attended the LA County Contract Connections event held in the City of Torrance, hosted by Supervisor Hahn, for small businesses in the surrounding area. He attended the ICA Board meeting in the City of Bell Gardens and mentioned they have a very nice City Hall. He did go to the Albertson's Food Drive but was at a different time shift and couldn't get there earlier to be with his Council colleagues. He attended the South Bay LGBTQ Art Show Case in the City of El Segundo. He said that he tried to attend an Assembly District 62 event held at LA Southwest College, but he couldn't make it in due to being stopped by people asking questions. He encouraged our community to use Gardena Direct to report illegal dumping, graffiti, etc. and the City of Gardena will take care of it.
- (4) MAYOR CERDA she attended the KABC SoCal Food Drive and thanked the entire City for participating. When she was first contacted about the Food Drive, she said she wanted to go big with Gardena and, in less than a week's time, all the departments came together to raise money, make donations of canned goods, and were there show their support that day. She especially thanked her colleagues who were there at Albertsons as early as 5:30 in the morning. She also heard that, by 3:00 p.m. that day, Gardena had already exceeded the sought-after quota of donations and SoCal Food Drive was extremely pleased with the response by our community. She reported that she attended two JPA meetings, dealing with gaming issues of our casinos. She mentioned that they have developed a new craft beer called "The Freeway City." That same evening, she attended the 2019 City of Gardena Summer Festival of Performing Arts where she saw a program with 200 youngsters performing what they had learned from the City's Dance Classes for ages 2 years to 13 years old. Last Saturday, June 22, she also attended the Healthcare Partners ribbon cutting. The Partners staff speak up to four languages to accommodate our diversified city and it is a great facility to check out. She attended the Gardena Dodgers Day and said they won, and it was a lot of fun. On Sunday, June 23, she attended a memorial service for Los Angeles County Lifeguard, Mr. Don Rohrer, who served in that position for over 44 years. Mr. Rohrer was instrumental in transitioning ocean lifeguards into the County Fire Department in 1994. She then reported that, on Monday, June 24, on behalf of the California Cities for Self-Reliance JPA, she met with Attorney General Xavier Becerra to discuss game regulations that will affect the future revenues of our local casinos. Later that evening, she attended the Dinner that followed the 9th Annual Police Foundation Golf Classic.

#### Collection Procedures

- The collection fees shall be pre-determined and conspicuously posted on each table
  prior to any cards being dealt or a round of play commencing. Collection rates and fees
  shall be determined prior to the start of play of any hand or round.
- Only one collection schedule option, which utilizes one table limit and the specified
  collection fees for that table limit, as listed above, shall be used at a table at any one
  time. Rates may not be calculated as a fraction or percentage of wagers made or
  winnings earned.
- Flat fees on wagers may be assessed at different collection rates; however, no more than five collection rates may be established per table.
- Larry Flynt's Lucky Lady Casino shall provide ample notice to patrons regarding the collection rates and fees, as well as the procedure for collecting them.
