GARDENA MILITARY VETERAN RECOGNITION

HONORING

LAWRENCE B. KILLENS

(selected by Mayor Pro Tem Tanaka)

Mr. Killens is a long-time resident of Gardena.

He served with the U.S. Marine Corps from December 22, 1972 through March 31, 1996.

While in the military, he served with the following Units:

- Marine Aircraft Group 39 (MAG 39) which provided utility helicopter support, close-in fire support, fire support coordination, aerial reconnaissance, observation and forward air control in aerial and ground escort operations during ship-to-shore movement and subsequent operations ashore.
- Marine Aircraft Group 11 (MAG 11)
- Headquarters and Service Battalion
- Marine Security Guard Battalion
- Schools Battalion Camp Pendleton
- Recruiting Station Chicago
- Recruiting Orange County

Among his multiple assignments, Killens participated in a Campaign known as

<u>Operation Frequent Wind</u> which was the final phase in the evacuation of American civilians and "at-risk" Vietnamese from Saigon, South Vietnam prior to the takeover of the city by the North Vietnamese Army (PAVN) in the Fall of Saigon.

It was carried out on April 29–30, 1975, during the last days of the Vietnam War. More than 7,000 people were evacuated by helicopter from various points in Saigon. The airlift resulted in a number of enduring images.

Killens was honorably discharged in March 1996, with the rank of Sergeant Major E-9.

For his exemplary military service, Killens was awarded the following:

- Navy Achievement Medal
- Vietnam Service Medal

Study Session on the role and responsibilities of the Planning Commission and brief overview of relevant laws.

Assistant City Attorney Lisa Kranitz put on a presentation of roles and responsibilities of the Planning Commission and a brief overview of relevant laws, as requested from the Planning Commissioners.

Vice-Chair Sherman asked whether a discussion of the Commissioners' ethical role was included within the presentation.

Ms. Kranitz stated that it was not included in this presentation as all Commissioners are required to attend an ethics training under AB 1234.

Vice-Chair Sherman asked how often they must attend an ethics training.

City Attorney Peter Wallin answered every two years.

Ms. Kranitz stated that there are AB 1234 trainings available online.

Mr. Wallin added that the Commissioners should have received an email from Chief Deputy City Clerk Becky Romero stating that the Commissioners could receive their ethics training by attending one of the presentations put on by the City Clerk's Office or by taking an online training.

ORAL COMMUNICATIONS FROM THE PUBLIC

There were no oral communications from the public.

COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DIRECTOR'S REPORT

City Manager Edward Medrano informed the Commission that the City has made changes to the compositions of the operating departments and as a result Community Development, which was once part of the General Services Department, will become its own department and the City will be recruiting for a new Community Development Director. Mr. Medrano went on to say that the City of Gardena had been operating for over a decade under a super department model where it had directors responsible for several different areas and that the City was going back to a model that was more common amongst other municipalities.

Chair Jackson asked for clarification on which departments would have their own directors.

Mr. Medrano explained that Parks and Recreation and Human Services are under one department, the legacy Public Works and Park Maintenance would be under the General Services Department, and Community Development would be its own separate department as are Administrative Services, GTrans, and the Police Department.

Vice-Chair Sherman asked if something happened with General Services Director Joseph Cruz.

Mr. Medrano answered no and stated that Joseph Cruz would be solely responsible for the General Services Department. Mr. Medrano went on to say that the scope of work for the former department was very vast and acting in that compacity was unrealistic for the directors and moving forward Community Development will have its own director, hopefully by the first quarter of the next year. Mr. Medrano stated that in the meantime Community Development Manager, Raymond Barragan will be attending the Planning Commission meetings. Mr. Medrano stated that he himself will be acting as the Community Development director and make himself available to the Planning Commission.

Mr. Medrano moved on to discuss the Planning and Development Forum that the staff would be presenting to the public on November 15, 2018 at 6:30pm. Mr. Medrano stated that community members had voiced their concerns on a number of projects that had come through the City, specifically on the Planning and entitlement process. Mr. Medrano stated that the recent single-room occupancy project on West 169th Street created a lot of dialog within the community about how the government functions in terms with the entitlement process and that the staff saw it as an opportunity to have a public forum on the matter. Mr. Medrano stated that a common question staff had received from the community is how projects are noticed. Mr. Medrano stated that this forum would be able to answer those types of questions and allow the community to provide their suggestions on the process.

Chair Jackson stated that she had received several questions from public on why certain businesses are allowed in certain areas and that it would be beneficial for the community to be informed of the Planning process.

Mr. Medrano stated that the forum will allow staff to answer these types of questions and others.

Chair Jackson asked if the Commissioners were allowed to attend.

Mr. Medrano answered yes and stated that Ms. Kranitz will be in attendance to answer questions as well.

Mr. Wallin asked if the forum would need to be noticed as Planning Commissioners and City Council members would be attending.

Mr. Medrano stated that they would get some guidance on that, however, added that it would not be a formal meeting but rather a forum for the public.

Ms. Kranitz stated that neither the City Council Members nor the Planning Commissioners will be seating on the dais.

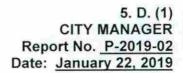
