Pet Licensing Requirements

- California law requires animals 4 months or older to be licensed
- Failure to obtain a license may result in a fine or penalty
- Licensing is an important means of identification and can help return lost pets

EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2019

EVERY OWNER MUST REGISTER THEIR
ANIMAL(S) AT CITY HALL**

Animal Licenses may be obtained by submitting:

- A license application form (online)
- Proof of rabies vaccination
- Proof of sterilization

**Discounted license fees are available for senior citizens
(age 60 or older). Seniors must submit proof of age
(official government issued identification).**
