Pet Licensing Requirements

- California law requires animals 4 months or older to be licensed
- Failure to obtain a license may result in a fine or penalty
- Licensing is an important means of identification and can help return lost pets

EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2019

LA COUNTY WILL NO LONGER PROCESS PET LICENSES FOR THE CITY

EVERY OWNER MUST REGISTER THEIR ANIMAL(S) AT CITY HALL

Animal Licenses may be obtained by submitting:

- A license application form (online)
- Proof of rabies vaccination
- Proof of sterilization

Discounted license fees are available for senior citizens (age 60 or older). Seniors must submit proof of age (official government issued identification).
