



# CHRISTMAS TREE RECYCLING

Thanks to special accommodations by the local refuse company, Waste Resources, residents of Gardena may recycle their Christmas trees during the week of **Thursday, December 26, 2019 through Saturday, January 18, 2020.** To take advantage of this service, residents should:

1. **REMOVE** all decorations, stand and nails from trees.
2. **CUT** trees in half that are taller than six (6) feet.
3. **PLACE** trees on the curbside, along with trash containers, on regular collection day.

\*Flocked trees and trees coated with fire retardant will be accepted.

Roll-off boxes will also be placed at the following three (3) City parks for residents to drop off their trees:
