If you wish to attend the City Council meeting in person, the City Council Chambers located at 1700 W. 162<sup>nd</sup> Street, Gardena, California will be open for this meeting and the public shall have the right to observe and offer public comment at this location. However, please note, seating is limited, you will be required to maintain appropriate social distancing, i.e, maintain a 6-foot distance between yourself and other individuals.

While you may attend this meeting in person, given the health risks associated with COVID-19, the City wants you to know that you can submit your comments and questions in writing for City Council consideration by sending them to the Deputy City Clerk at <u>bromero@cityofgardena.org</u>. To give the City Council adequate time to review your questions and comments, please submit your written comments prior to 1:00 p.m. on Thursday, March 19, 2020.

If you are watching the live stream and wish to make either a general public comment or to comment on a specific agenda item as it is being heard please submit your comment, limited to 200 words or less, to the Deputy City Clerk at <u>bromero@cityofgardena.org</u>. Every effort will be made to read your comment into the record, but some comments may not be read due to time limitations.

If you have travelled internationally and/or you have had direct contact with someone who has travelled internationally or tested positive for Coronavirus (COVID-19), or you are experiencing symptoms such as coughing, sneezing, fever, difficulty breathing or other flu-like symptoms, please <u>DO NOT ATTEND</u> this meeting in person.
