ENFORCING THE CLOSURE OF NON-ESSENTIAL BUSINESSES

Los Angeles County's "Safer at Home" Order requires the temporary closure of non-essential businesses and prohibition of events and gatherings of 10 people or more. For specific definitions of essential businesses, please refer to the official <u>County Order</u>.

Gardena Code Enforcement is abiding by the County Order and will continue to monitor the closure of non-essential businesses.

Non-essential businesses in question must produce a contact or correspondence with a County representative demonstrating that they are exempt from the non-essential list. Businesses that fail to prove exemption will be advised to close. Code Enforcement will be issuing citations for each day that the business is open and in violation of the County Order.
