As a reminder, Los Angeles County's "Safer at Home" Order is in effect through May 15, 2020. After careful review, City Council amended the Face Covering Order during the City Council Meeting on Tuesday, April 28, 2020. Gardena residents and visitors are no longer required to wear face coverings while driving alone or with another member of their household. FREE COVID-19 TESTING

GENERAL PUBLIC

The City of Los Angeles, in partnership with the County of Los Angeles and CORE (Community Organized Relief Effort), is providing FREE COVID-19 testing to Los Angeles County residents. For the general public, testing is currently available only for people with symptoms, such as fever, cough, and shortness of breath. Anyone with COVID-19 symptoms can now book a same or next day appointment.

FRONT LINE WORKERS

FREE testing is also available for any workers in the following categories, with or without symptoms of COVID-19:

- First Responders
- Critical Government Personnel
- Health Care Professionals
- Grocery Workers
- Delivery, Ride-share, and Public Transit Drivers
- Credentialed Members of the Media

TEMPORARY MORATORIUM ON EVICTIONS

On March 26, 2020, the City Council adopted Urgency Ordinance No. 1819, establishing a temporary moratorium on the eviction of residential and commercial tenants who are unable to pay rent due to the impacts of COVID-19.

To take advantage of the protections provided in Urgency Ordinance No. 1819, residential and commercial tenants are required to do the following within 30 days after the rent is due:

- Notify the landlord in writing of the substantial COVID-19 related financial impacts
- Provide documentation in writing establishing substantial COVID-19 related financial impacts
- Pay the portion of rent that the tenant is able to pay

Please keep in mind that a landlord may not evict a tenant if the tenant has done any of the following:

- Rent is overdue for a period of 30 days or less and the tenant notified the landlord as required by this ordinance
- Rent is overdue for a period of 31 days or more and the tenant complies with both requirements of this ordinance

If the tenant fails to provide the information in writing within the 30-day period, the landlord has the right to proceed with the eviction process. Please be advised that this ordinance does not intend to waive a tenant's obligation to pay back rent owed once this ordinance is no longer effective. If a tenant still has the means to pay rent, then they are expected to do so. A tenant will have up to 120 days after the expiration of this ordinance to pay the unpaid rent that is due. As of April 11, 2020, Gardena residents and visitors are required to wear face coverings that cover the nose and mouth while in public. Face coverings can be non-medical grade cloth coverings, including scarves and bandanas

The original Emergency Order was amended during the City Council Meeting on April 28, 2020, allowing individuals that are driving or riding in a vehicle alone or with other members of their household to do so without face coverings. The revised Order is available on our website: https://www.cityofgardena.org/covid-042920-afco

Individuals are required to wear face coverings while at any essential business, traveling to and from essential businesses or services and while out in public, including exercising outside of your place of residence. Please be advised that face coverings are to be used in addition to physical distancing and frequent handwashing.

Refer to LA County's Guidance for information on how to safely use and care for cloth face coverings. Check your local retailers and pharmacies to purchase cloth face coverings. CDC has also provided instructions on how to make your own cloth face covering at home on their website.









HOMELESS SHELTER REFERRALS

The City of Los Angeles opened thousands of emergency shelter beds to help get the homeless Angelenos indoors more quickly. As of March 31, there are 13 emergency shelters at recreation centers across the City. In addition, many winter shelter programs will remain until September 30, 2020. 












CLOSURES OF PARKS AND OPEN SPACES

ENFORCING THE CLOSURE OF NON-ESSENTIAL BUSINESSES

Los Angeles County's "Safer at Home" Order requires the temporary closure of nonessential businesses and prohibition of events and gatherings of 10 people or more. Gardena Code Enforcement is abiding by the County Order and will continue to monitor the closure of non-essential businesses.

PRICE GOUGING INFORMATION AND REPORTING

Price gouging is when sellers increase their prices for essential consumer goods and services during an emergency. According to California's Penal Code Section 396, it is illegal to raise the price of consumer goods by more than 10% after an emergency has been declared.


