FOUR-STAGE REOPENING PLAN

California's Pandemic Roadmap is a gradual, four-stage approach to modifying the Stay-at-Home Order. This reopening plan is contingent upon six key indicators outlined by the State:

- Ability to test, contact trace, isolate and support the exposed
- Ability to protect those at high risk for COVID-19
- Surge capacity for hospital and health systems
- Therapeutic development to meet the demand
- Ability of businesses, schools and childcare facilities to support physical distancing
- Determination of when to reinstitute measures like Stay-at-Home

On Monday, May 4, 2020, Governor Newsom announced that California can begin moving into the early phase of Stage 2, the reopening of low-risk workplaces with adaptations, as early as Friday, May 8, 2020. For a detailed breakdown of the statewide Pandemic Roadmap, please visit their [website](#).

Gardena will be using LA County's reopening framework as a guide to our City's reopening plan. City staff is working on guidelines for our residents, businesses, and visitors to follow throughout each of the four stages outlined by the State.
