Dear Gardena Resident,

We understand the dramatic impact of the COVID-19 pandemic on our residents; however, in many neighborhoods, the lack of street sweeping access has led to an accumulation of debris and pollution that jeopardizes the health and safety of our community.

Street sweeping is a critical health service, which collects tons of debris each year and prevents pollutants from washing into the ocean and other waterways. Streets can only be swept effectively when cars are out of the path of the sweeper.

Therefore, after 10 weeks of amnesty, the Gardena Police Department will resume street sweeping enforcement on Monday June 1st, 2020.

We thank you for your cooperation and continued patience as we make incremental progress toward re-opening Gardena.
