UPDATE ON COVID-19 IN GARDENA

As of today, the City of Gardena has 330 confirmed cases of COVID-19. The Emergency Operations Center has identified an increase in confirmed cases over the last two weeks.

Protecting the health of our community while reducing the potential for a resurgence is the City's top priority. Although many businesses have reopened for in-person services, please be advised that LA County's Safer at Home Order is still in effect. COVID-19 is still a significant threat to our community, and we are all truly **Safer at Home**.

Proper infection controls are critical to keeping our businesses open and moving through the Reopening Guidelines. While you are out in public, please ensure that you are practicing the protective actions to slow the spread of COVID-19 in our community.
