HEALTH OFFICER ORDER REGULATIONS

The State's new tier framework for reducing COVID-19 is based on each County's rate of new cases and positivity. Counties are required to remain in an assigned tier for at least three weeks before moving forward and must meet the next tier's criteria for two consecutive weeks. LA County is currently in Tier 1, indicating the transmission of COVID-19 is still widespread.

The City will continue to follow LA County Department of Public Health's Roadmap to Recovery. Hair salons and barbershops are now permitted to reopen indoor services at 25% maximum capacity. The following businesses must close their indoor operations:

- All restaurants for indoor, onsite dining
 Places of worship
- Cardrooms, satellite wagering facilities, Personal care establishments: nail and racetrack onsite wagering facilities
- Indoor portions and exhibits of museums, zoos, and aquariums
- Fitness facilities
- Non-essential office-based businesses

- salons, tanning salons, esthetician, skin care, cosmetology services, electrology, body art professionals, tattoo parlors, piercing shops, and massage therapy
- Indoor malls and shopping centers

The following businesses must remain closed at this time:

- Lounges and nightclubs
- Bars, breweries, tasting rooms, craft distilleries, and wineries
- Brewpubs, craft distilleries, breweries and wineries that are exempt from the definition of a food facility by California Health and Safety Code Section 113789(c) (5), and do not hold a health permit for preparing and serving food on site
- Public entertainment venues: movie theaters, live performance theaters, concert venues, theme parks and festivals
- Family entertainment centers: bowling alleys, arcades, miniature golf and batting cages
- Indoor or outdoor playgrounds for children, except those located within a school or childcare center
- Hot tubs, steam rooms and saunas not located on a residential property
- All events and gatherings unless specifically allowed by the Health Officer Order

CELEBRATING HALLOWEEN

On September 9, 2020, LA County Department of Public Health released guidance for celebrating Halloween in accordance with existing health regulations. Gatherings, events, and parties with non-household members are not permitted at this time. Carnivals, festivals, live entertainment, and haunted house attractions are prohibited.

Door to door trick-or-treating and trunk-or-treating is not recommended due to the difficulty of maintaining physical distancing and ensuring infection control protocols. For more information, please visit their <u>website</u>.

To ensure our residents are able to celebrate safely, the City will be hosting a Drive-Thru Halloween Route to pick up tricks or treats on Friday, October 30, 2020 beginning at 6:30pm. Our Graveyard of Goodies include City Hall Complex, Freeman Park, Johnson Park, Mas Fukai Park, and Rowley Park. To comply with health regulations, no walk-ups will be allowed and face coverings are required. For details, please contact us at (310) 217-9537.

GARDENA PARKS

Gardena Parks are open during regular park hours for activities such as walking, running, and tennis. <u>Tennis courts</u> are open with required adaptations on weekdays from 7:00am to 10:00am and 3:00pm to 8:00pm and weekends from 10:00am to 4:00pm.

<u>Baseball and softball fields</u> are also open for youth sports only upon reservation with required adaptations. The fields are available on weekdays from 4:30pm to 6:00pm and 6:00pm to 7:30pm. Playgrounds, other sports courts, and skate parks remain closed at this time. All City Park visitors must wear face coverings and adhere to physical distancing protocols.

APPOINTMENT ONLY FREE COVID-19 TESTING

GENERAL PUBLIC

All LA County Residents that are interested in being tested should first contact their Primary Care Provider or health plan about how to access testing. Testing offered by LA County is currently prioritized for residents with symptoms identified by CDC. Testing priority is also given to people working or living in places such as skilled nursing facilities, group homes, and residential care facilities, persons experiencing homelessness, and people who were in close contact with someone with COVID-19.

FRONT LINE WORKERS

FREE testing is also available for workers in the following categories, with or without symptoms of COVID-19:

- Healthcare
- Emergency Services
- Food and grocery
- Retail or manufacturing
- Public transportation
- Education

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Immigration status, insurance status, age, and underlying health issues do not affect eligibility for a COVID-19 test.

FACIAL COVERING REQUIRED

As of April 11, 2020, Gardena residents and visitors are required to wear face coverings that cover the nose and mouth while in public. Face coverings can be non-medical grade cloth coverings, including scarves and bandanas

The original Emergency Order was amended during the City Council Meeting on April 28, 2020, allowing individuals that are driving or riding in a vehicle alone or with other members of their household to do so without face coverings. Individuals are required to wear face coverings while at any essential business, traveling to and from essential businesses or services and while out in public. Please be advised that face coverings are to be used in addition to physical distancing and frequent handwashing.

Refer to LA County's Guidance for information on how to safely use and care for cloth face coverings. Check your local retailers and pharmacies to purchase cloth face coverings. CDC has also provided instructions on how to make your own cloth face covering at home on their website.

TEMPORARY MORATORIUM ON EVICTIONS

On March 26, 2020, the City Council adopted Urgency Ordinance No. 1819, establishing a temporary moratorium on the eviction of residential and commercial tenants who are unable to pay rent due to the impacts of COVID-19.

To take advantage of the protections provided in Urgency Ordinance No. 1819, residential and commercial tenants are required to do the following within 30 days after the rent is due:

- Notify the landlord in writing of the substantial COVID-19 related financial impacts
- Provide documentation in writing establishing substantial COVID-19 related financial impacts
- Pay the portion of rent that the tenant is able to pay

Please keep in mind that a landlord may not evict a tenant if the tenant has done any of the following:

- Rent is overdue for a period of 30 days or less and the tenant notified the landlord as required by this ordinance
- Rent is overdue for a period of 31 days or more and the tenant complies with both requirements of this ordinance

If the tenant fails to provide the information in writing within the 30-day period, the landlord has the right to proceed with the eviction process. Please be advised that this ordinance does not intend to waive a tenant's obligation to pay back rent owed once this ordinance is no longer effective. If a tenant still has the means to pay rent, then they are expected to do so. A tenant will have up to 120 days after the expiration of this ordinance to pay the unpaid rent that is due.
