Updates

- Over the last 2 weeks, the number of positive COVID-19 cases increased by 2.69% with an average daily increase of 0.20%.
- In comparison, LA County has experienced a 5.99% increase over the last 2 weeks.

Impacts

- **Healthcare Facilities:** Local healthcare facilities are stable and able to maintain all functions without assistance.
- **South Bay Infection Rate:** Among all 15 South Bay cities, Inglewood has the highest infection rate at 2.96% per capita, followed by Hawthorne at 2.48%. 2.26% of Gardena's population has tested positive for COVID-19.

County Updates

- LA County is in Tier 1 of the State's blueprint framework, indicating the transmission of COVID-19 is still widespread.
- Personal care establishments may reopen indoor services with modifications.

Business Assistance

- Over the last 2 weeks, the Economic Development Manager received 8 calls from businesses related to economic assistance.
- The Restaurant Pandemic Video Series launched on October 27, 2020. Mayor Tasha Cerda and City Manager Osorio visited Azuma to kick off the series. The video will be released to the public during Restaurant Week on November 8-14, 2020.

Outdoor Dining Program

- Restaurants continue to apply for outdoor dining with Community Development.
- In partnership with Yelp, the City has updated the **Outdoor Dining Map**. The interactive map showcases all participating restaurants.

Restaurant Week

- Restaurant Week will be hosted by the City and is scheduled for November 8-14, 2020.
- Engagement on @Dine_Gardena continues to grow – The account now has 1,599 followers.
