### **Updates**

- Over the last 2 weeks, the number of positive COVID-19 cases increased by 1.10% with an average daily increase of 0.09%.
- In comparison, LA County has experienced a 0.58% increase over the last 2 weeks.

## **Impacts**

- Healthcare Facilities: Local hospitals are no longer experiencing surges. Long-term care facilities remain stable.
- South Bay Infection Rate: Among all 15 South Bay cities, Inglewood has the highest infection rate at 12.42% per capita, followed by Hawthorne at 12.02%. Lawndale has an infection rate of 10.95%, and 10.51% of Gardena's population has tested positive.

#### **Gardena Parks**

 Baseball and softball fields at Rowley Park and Mas Fukai Park as well as soccer and football fields at Johnson Park are now open for youth and adult sports upon <u>reservation</u> with required protocols in place.

#### **Business Assistance**

- To assist businesses with reopening efforts, the Economic Development Department is visiting businesses to determine if they need access to PPE and answering questions related to required protocols.
- The Economic Development Manager is in the process of adding businesses to the Business Directory, which is hosted on Gardena Awaits.

## **Statewide Updates**

 On <u>April 6, 2021</u>, the State announced that it plans to fully reopen on June 15, 2021.
 Vaccine supply for Californians 16 years of age and older who wish to be vaccinated must be sufficient, and hospitalization rates must remain stable and low.

### **LA County Reopening Updates**

- The revised LA County Health Officer Order is effective <u>April 5, 2021</u>.
- A revised Health Officer Order allowing indoor events, meetings and gatherings with required adaptations will take effect April 15, 2021.

## **LA County Vaccine Updates**

- In accordance with the State, residents 16 years of age and older will be eligible for vaccination beginning April 15, 2021.
- Over 5.1 million doses of the vaccine have been administered across LA County, and over 1.8 million people received their second dose or the single dose Johnson & Johnson vaccine. 19,453 Gardena residents have been vaccinated as of April 4, 2021.

# **Current Vaccination Status**

LA County Department of Public Health is currently vaccinating individuals in Phase 1A and Phase 1B. Eligible groups include:

- Healthcare workers
- Residents of long-term care facilities
- Residents 50 years of age or older
- Education and Childcare
- Emergency Services

- Food and Agriculture
- People with serious health conditions/disabilities
- People who live or work in congregate living spaces
- Janitorial, Custodial, and Maintenance Services
- <u>Transportation and Logistics</u>
- To be vaccinated, you will need to demonstrate proof of identity, proof that you live or work in LA County, <u>AND</u> proof that you are in an eligible group. For more information related to eligibility, visit LA County Department of Public Health's <u>website</u>.
- Individuals receiving their second dose must bring their white vaccine record card or electronic vaccine record AND a photo ID to their appointment.

## **Information for Fully Vaccinated People:**

- **LA County's Travel Advisory and Guidance** states that fully vaccinated travelers may travel domestically without a pre- or post-travel test and without quarantining if they remain asymptomatic. Fully vaccinated people may also visit indoors with a small number of other fully vaccinated people without a mask or physical distancing. Additional information can be found **here**.
- Fully vaccinated people should continue to wear a mask and physical distance in public.

## **Gardena Vaccination Locations**

The Emergency Operations Center and Recreation and Human Services Department are coordinating with Medical Mission Adventures, a nonprofit collaborating with LA County Department of Public Health, to host a vaccination clinic at Johnson Park. More information will be forthcoming.
