LA County Reopening Updates

- LA County is now in the Yellow Tier of the State's **Blueprint for a Safer Economy**. The revised LA County Health Officer Order is effective **May 6, 2021**. The protocols set forth by LA County Department of Public Health may vary for fully vaccinated individuals.

Updates

- Over the last 2 weeks, the number of positive COVID-19 cases increased by 0.45% with an average daily increase of 0.04%.
- In comparison, LA County has experienced a 0.29% increase over the last 2 weeks.

Impacts

- Healthcare Facilities:** Local hospitals are no longer experiencing surges. Long-term care facilities remain stable.
- South Bay Infection Rate:** Among all 15 South Bay cities, Inglewood has the highest infection rate at 12.55% per capita, followed by Hawthorne at 12.18%. Lawndale has an infection rate of 11.10%, and 10.63% of Gardena's population has tested positive.

Gardena Parks

- Baseball and softball fields at Rowley Park and Mas Fukai Park as well as soccer and football fields at Johnson Park are open for youth and adult sports upon **reservation** with required protocols in place.

Permits & Business Assistance

- Garage sales and yard sales are now permitted in accordance with LA County's guidance for **informal social gatherings**. You can apply for a garage sale permit on our **website**.
- The Economic Development Manager is in the process of planning a joint PPE giveaway for the business community with the Gardena Chamber of Commerce.

LA County Vaccine Updates

- In accordance with the State, residents 16 years of age and older are now eligible for the COVID-19 vaccine.
- To date, over 8.3 million doses of the vaccine have been administered across LA County.

Gardena Vaccination Efforts

- As of May 7, 2021, 29,242 Gardena residents have received at least one dose of the vaccine.
- The City has partnered with Medical Mission Adventures to host a free vaccination clinic for anyone 18 years or older on March 15, 2021 from 9:00am to 2:00pm. Call (310) 217-9552 to schedule your appointment for the Moderna vaccine. The clinic for the second dose is scheduled for June 12, 2021.
