		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All services must be by appointment only, and staff must use a fitted N95 mask or face covering and face shield when providing services that require customers/clients to remove their face covering • Workers are not permitted to see multiple customers at once • Employee and customer screenings must be conducted before entering the workspace (can be done remotely or in person upon arrival) • LACDPH protocol <p>Limited Services: Open April 5, 2021</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Limited services include businesses that can provide services to the public while maintaining appropriate physical distancing from customers or the public • May reopen indoor operations at 75% maximum occupancy • LACDPH protocol • LACDPH protocol for car washes <p>Restaurants, Breweries, Distilleries & Wineries: Open May 6, 2021</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Restaurants and other food facilities that prepare and serve food may open for take-out, drive-thru, delivery, outdoor dining, and indoor dining at 50% maximum occupancy or 200 people, whichever is fewer • No more than six people from the same household are permitted to sit together; if fully vaccinated, up to six households may be seated together indoors and up to eight may be seated outdoors • Tables must be reconfigured so that all tables are at least six feet apart, and indoor seating shall be limited to no more than six people
