PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT on Tuesday, January 20, 2026, at 7:00 p.m., or soon thereafter, the Planning and Environmental Quality Commission of the City of Gardena will conduct a public hearing **at 1700 West 162nd Street, Gardena, CA, in the City Hall Council Chambers,** to consider the following:

**MODIFICAITON TO AMEND CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT #9-04
AND ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT #13-25**

A request to approve an amendment to modify Conditional Use Permit (CUP) #9-04, per section 18.32.030.B of the Gardena Municipal Code, to allow the sales of beer, wine, and distilled spirits for off-site consumption and on-site instructional tastings located in an existing retail store in the General Commercial (C-3) zone.

Environmental Consideration: The project is being considered for a categorical exemption from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Section 15301 (Class 1, Existing Facilities), which exempts negligible or no expansions of use in existing facilities from the provisions of CEQA.
