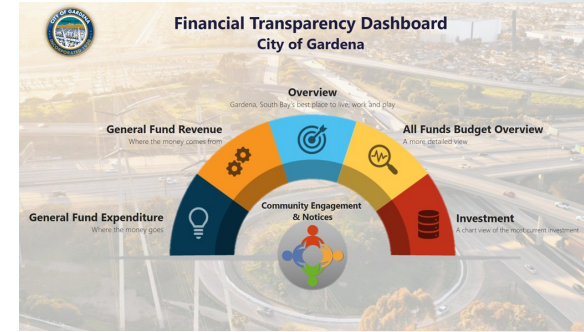

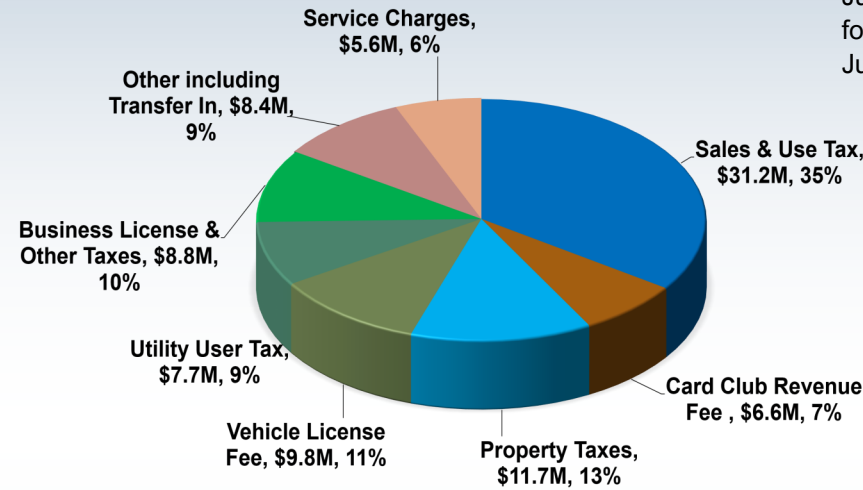

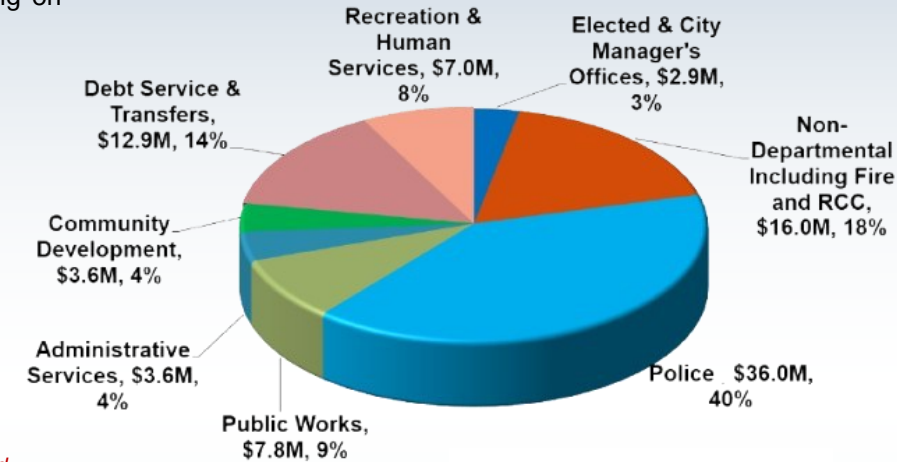


Chart reflects the Adopted Fiscal Year 2026-2027 Budget
